\$1 million Available for Permanent Supportive Housing

Application deadline extended to July 28

Nonprofit organizations wanting to develop permanent supportive housing for the homeless or persons with disabilities [can now apply for \\$1 million in federal funding](#) through DSHA.

The projects, which may include new construction or rehabilitation, should serve people who are homeless; who are homeless and experience mental health or substance abuse issues; or who have disabilities, particularly at high risk of homelessness or institutionalization. They must provide long-term permanent housing with supportive services, allowing residents to live as independently as possible.

The loan funding comes from both the National Housing Trust Fund and the HOME Investments Partnership Program, both federal funds administered by DSHA. Applicants must be 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations and complete an application available at destatehousing.com. Applications are due by 4 p.m.
