Wilmington Land Bank Starts First Project



The Wilmington Neighborhood Conservancy Land Bank, supported by Delaware's Strong Neighborhoods Housing Fund, began work this week on its first partnership project, demolishing two long-vacant homes to make way for affordable housing for first-time homeowners.

six new homes from the Land Bank and partner New Castle County Habitat for Humanity.

The Strong Neighborhoods Housing Fund last year awarded \$645,000 to the Land Bank for demolition and other work. In total, Wilmington projects received \$2.1 million from the Fund, designed to fight blight and address vacant, abandoned or foreclosed properties.

"We are pleased to help support these projects from the Land Bank and its partners, and look forward to seeing the city become stronger," said DSHA Director Anas Ben Addi.
