DSHA Bowls for Veterans



For the third year the Delaware State Housing Authority, organized some 35 employees and friends into bowling teams at Dover Bowl-A-Rama at Rodney Village to raise money for the Delaware Veterans Trust Fund.

The teams raised \$737 during the 90-minute competition for the Delaware Veterans Trust Fund, which helps identify housing for homeless veterans.

The purpose of the Delaware Veterans Trust Fund is to provide financial assistance or grants to assist Delaware Veterans with health care requirements, shelter, housing assistance, utilities, and educational or training programs. The Trust Fund accomplished this by raising funds to assist veterans and their families.

One hundred percent of contributions to the Trust Fund are tax deductible and all contributions are returned to veterans without deduction for overhead, salaries or any other purposes.

DSHA wins 23rd award for financial excellence



The Delaware State Housing Authority has earned a national award for accounting and financial reporting, extending its streak for the 23rd consecutive year.

DSHA recently received a Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Accounting from the Government Finance Officers Association of the United States and Canada for its fiscal year 2017 comprehensive annual financial report.

The award is the highest form of recognition that a government body can receive for financial reporting. Judging was conducted by an impartial panel to meet the high standards of the GFOA's program, including transparency and ease of understanding.

others assess DSHA's financial condition.

New Home4Good Funding Fights Homelessness



To assist nonprofit organizations working on homelessness initiatives, DSHA and the Federal Home Loan Bank of Pittsburgh have partnered to support stable housing for individuals and families who are homeless or at risk of homelessness.

The new Home4Good program is now accepting applications for funding projects that include Rapid Re-Housing, Homelessness Diversion, Homelessness Prevention, and Innovation. Home4Good has \$1.2 million in funds available, an increase of \$700,000 over prior homelessness funding initiatives. Home4Good will now fund all activities that were previously supported by the Housing Support grants from the state Housing Development Fund.
