Delaware Lieutenant Governor Bethany Hall-Long joined Delaware State Housing Authority (DSHA) Director Anas Ben Addi as they honored 58 students in the DSHA housing community for achieving academic excellence by making the honor roll and having perfect

attendance, with a luncheon and awards ceremony at Polytech High School last week.

The annual luncheon has been a tradition at DSHA for more than 20 years and serves as a way to recognize the children's successes and highlights the importance of a support system.

"You know that your achievements and accomplishments are not about luck," said Director Ben Addi. "There was no luck involved in homework, in writing research papers, or in giving presentations. There is only hard work, dedication, and curiosity. This type of achievement truly takes a village – bringing together everyone to play critical roles and offer their support."

Students were recognized from McLane Gardens, Burton Village, Clarks Corner, Hickory Tree, Laverty Lane, Liberty Court and Mifflin Meadows.

New Home4Good Funding Fights Homelessness Deadline August 27



To assist nonprofit organizations working on homelessness initiatives, DSHA and the Federal Home Loan Bank of Pittsburgh have partnered to support stable housing for individuals and families who are homeless or at risk of homelessness.

The new Home4Good program is now accepting applications for funding projects that include Rapid Re-Housing, Homelessness Diversion, Homelessness Prevention, and Innovation. Home4Good has \$1.2 million in funds available, an increase of \$700,000 over prior homelessness funding initiatives. Home4Good will now fund all activities that were previously supported by the Housing Support grants from the

state Housing Development Fund.
