Foreclosure Workshops

Delaware homeowners who face foreclosure, have fallen behind on their mortgage payments, or have questions about their mortgage can meet with lenders and housing counselors at two upcoming workshops in Dover on September 17 and Wilmington on September 18.

The foreclosure workshops will be September 17 from 1 p.m. to 7 p.m., at the Modern Maturity Center, 1121 Forrest Avenue, Dover, and September 18 from 3 p.m. to 7 p.m., at the DoubleTree by Hilton Wilmington, 4727 Concord Pike Wilmington.

At each free workshop, homeowners can also get

information from the Attorney General's Office and the Delaware State Housing Authority about government programs, the Delaware foreclosure timeline, and preventing foreclosure frauds and scams. No reservations or appointments are needed.

New Home4Good Funding Fights Homelessness Deadline August 27



To assist nonprofit organizations working on homelessness initiatives, DSHA and the Federal Home Loan Bank of Pittsburgh have partnered to support stable housing for individuals and families who are homeless or at risk of homelessness.

The new Home4Good program is now accepting applications for funding projects that include Rapid Re-Housing, Homelessness Diversion, Homelessness Prevention, and Innovation. Home4Good has \$1.2 million in funds available, an increase of \$700,000 over prior homelessness funding initiatives. Home4Good

will now fund all activities that were previously supported by the Housing Support grants from the state Housing Development Fund.
