Foreclosure Workshops

Delaware homeowners who face foreclosure, have fallen behind on their mortgage payments, or have questions about their mortgage can meet with lenders and housing counselors at two upcoming workshops in Dover on September 17 and Wilmington on September 18.

The foreclosure workshops will be September 17 from 1 p.m. to 7 pm., at the Modern Maturity Center, 1121 Forrest Avenue, Dover, and September 18 from 3 p.m. to 7 p.m., at the DoubleTree by Hilton Wilmington, 4727 Concord Pike Wilmington.

At each free workshop, homeowners can also get information from the Attorney General's Office and the Delaware State Housing Authority about government programs, the Delaware foreclosure

timeline, and preventing foreclosure frauds and scams.
