Transforming, Creating, and Preserving Our Neighborhoods - \$4.5 Million in Funding Now Available!

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Help strengthen our communities with funding from DSHA! Nonprofit organizations, local jurisdictions, for-profit developers and others are now invited to apply for funding from DSHA's Strong Neighborhoods Housing Fund (SNHF) and Housing Development Fund (HDF). More than \$4.5 million in funding is available to eligible applicants.

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[SNHF funding](#) is used to transform neighborhoods throughout Delaware who are experiencing blight, large numbers of vacant or abandoned properties, or other forms of stress, including high crime. Applications for this round of funding must be submitted no later than March 8, 2019.

[HDF funding](#) is available in the areas of Homeownership Production and Preservation. Applicant projects should create affordable, decent, safe, and sanitary housing or work to preserve owner-occupied housing for very low- to moderate-income households in Delaware. Homeownership Preservation funds must be used in SNHF priority areas.

Applications for Homeownership Production funds from HDF must be submitted no later than April 5, 2019. Applications for Homeownership Preservation funds from HDF will be accepted on a rolling basis going forward.

Apply for a Downtown Investment Rebate!



Help transform Delaware's downtowns! DSHA is accepting applications through January 2019 for large project reservations through the Downtown Development Districts Rebate Program.

The program provides rebates for up to 20 percent on qualified real property investments in one of the eight designated downtown districts, in Dover, Georgetown, Harrington, Laurel, Milford, Seaford, Smyrna and Wilmington.
