Black History Month Fact: U.S. Fair Housing Act



In celebration of Black History Month, we thought we'd share information about the U.S. Fair Housing Act. The U.S. Fair Housing Act of 1968 prohibited housing discrimination based on race, color, religion or national origin. The enactment of the federal Fair Housing Act on April 11, 1968 came only after a long and difficult journey.

From 1966-1967, Congress regularly considered the fair housing bill, but failed to garner a strong enough majority for its passage. However, when the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. was assassinated on April 4, 1968, President Lyndon Johnson utilized this national tragedy to urge for the bill's speedy Congressional approval.
