APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Mr. Julian moved and Ms. Harrington seconded that the Minutes of March 13, 2019 meeting be approved. The minutes were approved unanimously.

DSHA REPORT – Ms. Eliason

Budget

- Bond Bill hearing was on April 4th. Mr. White was present and spoke on behalf of Council. Speakers for the DDD, Strong Neighborhood Housing Fund, and ARHP were also present to speak in favor and on behalf of the programs they represented.
- o There is an active bill to extend the Delaware Mandatory Residential Foreclosure Mediation program to 2024.
- Applications for the SNHF were due March 8th and DSHA received 9 applications.
 A review panel will be going over the application on April 11th to rank them for the distribution of the \$3 million allocated for the program.
- o Homeownership application for the HDF were due April 4th and DSHA again received 9 applications. A review panel will be set up for these applications.
- o LIHTC applications are due at the end of April.
- An application was received on March 28th for the Housing Trust Fund and currently being reviewed.
- o DSHA received its first predevelopment loan application.
- o In January the Governor announced he would be reopening a new round for towns seeking designation as a DDD. This round will close on May 15th. There are currently about 9 towns interested in putting in application for designation. The Office of State Planning manages this process. DSHA is currently working with the Division of Small Business who is looking to hire a person to provide technical assistance to the districts in marketing and economic development.
- As a resource for the DDD program, DSHA will be attending some of the outreach meetings being held by the Division of Small Business on the Opportunity Zones which is geographically related to the DDD.
- On the Federal Budget, the Administration's proposed budget has proposed dramatic cuts to HUD programs, eliminating HOME, CDBG, Homeless Assistance grants, Housing Choice Voucher, Public Housing, Housing Counseling and Rental Assistance, USDA/RD Direct Mortgage Loans, and terminate contributions to the National Housing Trust Fund and Capital Magnet Fund which supports Community Development Financial Institutions.
