II. Review Task Force Charge & Subcommittee Charge

DSHA Chief Strategy Advisor Caitlin Del Collo went through the PowerPoint presentation reviewing the Affordable Housing Production Task Force charge and specifically how this subcommittee is part of that process.

Ms. Del Collo then shared information about projected housing needs from the 2023 Housing Needs Assessment.

IV. Brainstorming Exercise to Prioritize Ideas

i. Overview of Barriers to Utilizing MH for Homeownership

At 10:30, Mr. Heisler began his PowerPoint presentation. There was a discussion about vouchers, explained by Ms. Del Collo. Items from this discussion were put in the "parking lot," which is a list of items for consideration that don't neatly fit in the current discussion but could be part of an overall response. Mr. Heisler suggested everyone read the materials that were provided for this meeting. Items in the parking lot: vouchers used for manufactured housing; housing quality in existing manufactured housing stock; Senator Hoffner's bill; and rents/rent control.

ii. Financial Options (Including Resident-Owned Communities)

iii. Review of Information Provided by Member Fred Neil

11:15am – Mr. Heisler asked Mr. Neil to review the letters/attachments he sent for this meeting. There was some discussion about utilities after the presentation. Some items from this discussion were included in the "parking lot." Mr. Heisler asked about "affordability" in the scope of manufactured housing: he ascertains that more regulation = less affordable housing. Ms. Del Collo shared page 116 of the 2023 Housing Needs Assessment Full Report to show that "affordable" means you do not exceed 30% of your gross income.

iv. Chattel vs. Real Property

Mr. Heisler talked about the meaning of chattel, which includes all property that is not real property. Manufactured housing is considered chattel. Mr. Heisler will send more information in the next week.

v. Entitlements/Design Based Regulations: Can MHC be used for Infill Housing?

Mr. Heisler discussed architectural standards. Worth having a discussion and will share more information. Discussion about "equal treatment" laws and dealing with regulatory structures.

vi. Mechanisms for Purchase of MH Communities: Positive or Negative Impacts? vii. Other Topics

Ms. Del Collo announced the Regulatory and Permitting Subcommittee meeting, scheduled for 10/30/2024.
